

SCIT Report/Recommendations

July 13, 2022

- 1. 3 way Stop Request at Couch and Ann SCIT discussed this issue. Options that can improve traffic at this intersection is to remove/modify obstruction, reduce speed, or install traffic control devices such as adding stop signs on Couch, if they are warranted by the MUTCD. One of the warrants needed by MUTCD is a history of crashes. Police completed a crash history within the last 5 years and determined no crashes within the last 5 years. The speed limit on Couch is 25 miles per hour. SCIT recommends that the tree obstruction be removed that is within the stopping sight distance located just behind the sidewalk at 367 Couch Avenue. This will be passed on to the City Forester for his review if this tree is a Private or a Tree belonging to the City for removal.
- 2. No Parking restriction "here to corner" north side of Morningside at Taylor SCIT discussed the no parking restriction and has recommended approval of the no parking restriction. The street department will be notified to install the no parking restriction.
- 3. Speed Counter Update Speed counters had had issues with downloading speed and count information. Other speed counters are being investigated for purchasing.
- 4. Request for Traffic Signals at Adams Avenue and Woodlawn Avenue SCIT Recommends that this being sent to St. Louis County Department of Transportation for a traffic study to be completed.
