AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$7,103,897 FROM THE ELECTRIC FUND BALANCE TO THE ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT ELECTRICITY ACCOUNT FOR PURCHASE POWER EXPENSES AND WHOLESALE POWER REVENUES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023.

WHEREAS, during Fiscal Year 2022/2023 volatility in the natural gas market caused price spikes in the price of power on the grid, and

WHEREAS, consequently, Kirkwood Electric experienced a significant increase in its wholesale purchase price expenditures and an increase in its revenue associated with sales of power in the wholesale market, and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$7,103,897 needs to be appropriated from the Electric Fund Balance to Account #501-2111-480.62.01 (Electricity) for Fiscal Year 2022/2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Funds in the amount of \$7,103,897 are hereby appropriated from the Electric Fund Balance to Account #501-2111-480.62.01 (Electricity) for Fiscal Year 2022/2023.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval, as provided by law.

Goal # & Title Goal #2 - Governance and Civic Engagement

Background To Issue:

During FY23 volatility in the natural gas market caused price spikes in the price of power on the grid. consequently, Kirkwood Electric saw a significant increase in its wholesale purchase price expenditures. In conjunction with the increase in the expense for power, Kirkwood Electric saw an equivalent increase in its revenue associated with sales of power in the wholesale market. In September, Kirkwood Electric modified its rates with the fuel adjustment to maintain the appropriate cash for purchase power transactions during the year. the fiscal year has now been completed and the financial statements are being prepared.

Recommendations and Action Requested:

The Electric Department recommends approval of an ordinance to amend the Electric Department's budget to reflect the actual purchase power expense and wholesale power revenue experienced in FY23.

Alternatives Available:





In March 2022, the City of Kirkwood adopted its Vision Zero Action Plan, a culmination of months of effort to build community consensus around transportation safety issues and develop actionable strategies to eliminate fatal and severe injury crashes by 2042. The Vision Zero Toolbox developed as part of that plan contains a variety of policy, design, and programmatic strategies to address arterial crashes, vulnerable road user crashes, and behavior-related crashes. 
