# LANDMARKS/ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS DISCUSSION (continued from September 7, 2023)

Discussion continued from the September 7<sup>th</sup> meeting on the proposed Ordinance amendments. Some discussion is as follows:

- Concerns regarding the big changes to the Historic District
  - Under the proposed new Ordinance; new home construction and new accessory construction will go to Landmarks for approval. Additions will also go to Landmarks for approval. All appeals will still go to City Council.
- Comments made regarding making citizens aware of the all hard work and research that went into this proposed ordinance amendment.
- Concerns about the appeal process and how it will work in the future.
  - Under the existing code, appeals go the City Council and if someone is not satisfied with Council ruling, then it goes to Circuit Court. This process will not change.
- Concerns regarding if Kirkwood declared an area without homeowners?
  - o In the 1980's and 1990's the City declared areas landmarks without property owner consent.
- Suggestion for a special work session prior to Public meeting for the proposed ordinance.
