

SCIT Report / Recommendations

October 11, 2023

New Business

- Request for Speed Humps: Forest between Big Bend and Railroad Tracks SCIT discussed this speed bump addition. SCIT will develop warrant / scoring parameters and will hold response until November's meeting.
- ADA and Safe Unobstructed Site Line Enforcement SCIT discussed the complaint regarding parking being obstructed due to The James construction. Police will place and enforce temporary No-Parking signs on Washington Avenue. The City will contact Brinkman and review their parking plan for compliance.
- 3. **Request for Speed Humps: Ohlman Avenue and Gordon Place** SCIT discussed the request for a speed humps on Ohlman and Gordon and "Children Ahead" sign. SCIT determined that no speed humps or signing is warranted due to:
 - a. Low traffic volume
 - b. Sign is not a sign posted by the City
 - c. Suggest a Speed Trailer request be made
- 4. **Speed Hump Guidelines** SCIT discuss warrants for speed humps. The City Engineer will use the parameters mentioned in the City of Kirkwood "Traffic Calming Guidance" Manual prepared by Alta and issued April 2020, to determine prioritization criteria SCIT will use to evaluate traffic-calming actions. The City Engineer will present at the November meeting.

Additional Discussion Items

- 1. Parking by the Kirkwood Performing Arts Center just North of Clinton A CitySource complaint about event parking blocking the entrance to 364 South Taylor. SCIT reviewed the complaint. SCIT determined that the complaint was not actionable.
- 2. Parking on Chopin Drive at West Essex Avenue A complaint was received that during Kirkwood High School Events parking is routinely being made at the intersection on Chopin making it difficult for emergency vehicles to enter. SCIT reviewed the complaint. There is "No Parking" on Chopin 30 feet from West Essex. Action by SCIT. The Street Department will create aa striping plan and mark out that area.
