Notice is hereby given to all interested persons that a public open house meeting will be held in-person in Room 200 at the Kirkwood Performing Arts Center, located at 210 E Monroe Ave, Kirkwood, MO 63122 on Thursday, July 11, 2024, from 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. This meeting is of significant importance as it provides an opportunity for all interested parties to contribute to the design of the South Clay Avenue Resurfacing Project, a project that will greatly impact our community. No formal presentation will be made at the in-person public meeting. Handicap access is available. Additional information can be found on the city's website at www.kirkwoodmo.org/projects. The S. Clay Ave project will consist of the following improvements:

- Asphalt Milling and Overlay - (Approximately 3,325 Linear Feet)
- Concrete Curb Repair - Approximately 80% of curbs are anticipated to be replaced.
- Non-ADA Compliant Concrete Curb Ramp Replacements
- Non-ADA Compliant Sidewalk Replacement
- Raised Intersections at Jefferson and Argonne
- ADA Compliant Crosswalks / Realign Skewed Crosswalks
- Minimal Enclosed Storm Sewer System Modifications
- Pavement Marking & Signage Updates

Preliminary plans, maps, plats, environmental documentation, and other detailed information prepared by the City of Kirkwood's engineering consultant (IMEG Corporation) will be available at the public meeting. We are committed to transparency and want to ensure that you have all the information you need to understand the project and its potential impact on our community.

Tentative schedules for easement acquisition and construction will be discussed in the open house-style format.

This format is designed to encourage open dialogue and allow for a more interactive discussion about the project.
