LET'S ROLL OUT!:

Our 1st rolling stock capital purchase of the year has arrived. The Ford F150 that will replace the Park Forman truck is in the process of being outfitted with safety lights and hardware before it is put into service. Once it is online the old truck will be sent over to the Fleet department to be taken out of service and put up for sale on the government auction website GovDeals. We are still waiting on the new trash truck and the 1 ton dump truck that was re-appropriated from FY24. The last updates were that the trash tuck is waiting on electrical components, and the dump truck is in line to get the bed put on.

OUR SEALCOAT OF APPROVAL!:

The tennis court parking lot sealcoat and strip project has been completed. Over the course of 3 days the lot received 2 coats of sealant and was restriped for parking. We were also able to add tar crack filling for some of the larger cracks since the project came in under budget. We budgeted \$10,000, and the final bill was \$7,051.19. We hope to get into a cycle of preventative maintenance like this to help extend the longevity of the rest of our parking lots too.

IT'S BEGINNING TO LOOK A LOT LIKE...GREENTREE!:

Preparations for the Greentree festival are starting to ramp up! I have been getting all of our ducks in a row, and a lot of the behind the scenes planning and administrative tasks on the Parks side are ready to go. The parks staff has started repairing walkways and

working on eliminating potential trip hazards and will soon shift to other safety related issues and setup to ensure a welcoming and safe environment for the festival goers.

SO LONG AND THANKS FOR ALL THE FISH!:

The seasonal summer help that fills in the gaps during the summer months are all done for the year. John, Isaac, and Noah all did a great job this summer, but they are heading back to school. Isaac goes to grad school locally, so he will continue to help on some weekend shifts and at the Greentree Festival. The 2 extended seasonal employees Brian and Anne that work with our Horticulture staff will still be around into October.
