City-Wide Stormwater Plan (Commercial)

Notice is hereby given to all interested persons that the first of two public open house meetings will be held in person at the Kirkwood Performing Arts Center, located at 210 East Monroe, on Tuesday, October 8, 2024, from 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. Handicap access is available. All interested persons can comment about their stormwater concerns in Kirkwood. The program's goal is to address the community's highest-priority stormwater concerns. Priority is determined by each project's cost versus benefit so that your tax dollars make the biggest impact. Below are the three phases of the program.

PHASE I: Data Collection

- Collect information from residents, businesses, and stakeholders about stormwater problems
- Determine the frequency and severity of problems
- Investigate the source of the problems

PHASE II: Conceptual Development and Prioritization

- Consolidate individual problems into problem areas to be addressed by stormwater infrastructure projects
- Develop conceptual solutions and cost estimates for those stormwater infrastructure projects
- Prioritize the stormwater infrastructure projects for Phase III based on cost versus benefit.
- Create examples of self-help storm improvements for residents
- The result of this Phase is a Stormwater Master Plan, which is a prioritized list of projects

PHASE III: Implementation

- Design and construct improvements from the Stormwater Master Plan to alleviate flooding and erosion.
