RULES AND GUIDELINES:

- The contest is open to anyone, school -age and older.
- Two age categories: 1) Under age 18.2) Age 18 and older.
- Up to three images per entrant will be accepted.
- All photos must be submitted online at: www.youjudgeit.org/ kirkwoodartsfoundation between March 15 and June 30, 2019.
- · Required file format: jpeg
- The submission must include a completed application, agreement to all terms and conditions, and payment of fees.

- Applicant agrees that all submitted photos may be used by the Kirkwood Arts
 Commission, the Kirkwood Arts Foundation, and the City of Kirkwood in both
 print and electronic media.
- Fees are: \$20/18 and older; \$10 under age 18.
- The primary subject of all entries must incorporate one or more images of cars and/or guitars. Photos must be familyfriendly, as determined by the Arts Commission.
- Images may be enhanced via darkroom or digital post-processing and editing.
 The original photographs must have been created on or after June 1, 2017, on film or digitally.

JUDGING:

- Two professional photographers will "blind" judge the photos online.
- Criteria will include: Creativity, originality, expression of theme, and excellence.
- Decisions of the judges will be final.

Note: While Kirkwood's Route 66 Cars and Guitars Festival is an excellent source of subject matter for photos, **it is not required**

that contest photos be taken at this year's festival (on June 8.)



AWARDS: CASH PRIZES
