PARC PARTNERS AND COURTNEY SHUPE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



PARC AND SHUPE PROGRAMS

Designed to assist people whose families or households face economic challenges, in using Kirkwood Parks and Recreation facilities.

To qualify, individuals or their household must be eligible for one of the following programs:

- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Aid to Dependent Children
- Section 8 or other housing assistance program
- Medicaid, MC+ or Medical Assistance for Families (MAF)
- Title I meal support program
- Supplemental Social Security Income (SSI)

Participants must be residents of Kirkwood (Glendale or Oakland resident for aquatic activities only).

ELIGIBLE FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS

Approved children are eligible for one free session of swim lessons each summer and 1/2 off all season passes, daily admissions and programs offered by Kirkwood Parks and Recreation.

Approved adults are eligible for 1/2 off all season passes, daily admissions and programs offered by Kirkwood Parks and Recreation.

HOW TO USE THE PARC & SHUPE PROGRAMS

Applications are available at the Community Center front desk or at kirkwoodparksandrec.org
Return the completed form, with the requested documentation to Brenton Ward, 111 S. Geyer Rd., Kirkwood MO 63122 or wardbm@kirkwoodmo.org

Your application will be reviewed, and you will be notified as to your standing in the program. If accepted, you will be given a free PARC/ Shupe membership that is valid for two years. You will be issued a Kirkwood Resident ID card. Upon presenting this card at the Pool, Ice Rink or Tennis Courts you will be given the 50% PARC/ Shupe discount.
