

FOR SINGLE FAMILY ONLY	:						
Failure to obtain a building permit, or complete the demolition and restore the site including grading, seeding/strawing and/or sodding and abate any code violations thereon within 60 days shall result in the deposit being forfeited to the City of Kirkwood. The City, after receiving a written request from the applicant or Contractor, may at its sole discretion extend the permit for one or more additional thirty (30) day period if warranted by conditions such as weather. The forfeiting of the deposit does not relieve the applicant from completing all work. The City assumes no responsibility to complete such improvements; however, if the City performs the site restoration, the cost to perform such work plus a \$500 administrative fee shall be deducted from the deposit. Within 60 days of issuance of the demolition permit the applicant or contractor shall make a written request to the City for return of the deposit after the foundation has been approved on the new house being built or ground cover has been established. For information call 822-5822. Deposit is not required for demolitions in an approved subdivision or project that has been reviewed by Planning and Zoning Commission and there is a valid performance guarantee on file with the City for the subdivision.


