




# Flu Shot Clinic

**Date:** October 13, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

**Where:** Kirkwood Community Center, 111 S. Geyer Road

## How it Works:

- **Form:** You will complete the required form the day of the event. You must bring your Driver's License and insurance card with you, as well.
- **Eligibility:** This vaccination is for adults and children 12 years old and older. Children under the age of 12 can  only receive the vaccination with a doctor's prescription.
- **Cost:** There is **no cost and no copay** for the vaccination for City employees and their insured dependents. Your insurance will be billed for the vaccination. This is why you must bring your insurance card with you.
- **No Insurance:** If you do not have insurance, there is still no cost to you. Indicate on the form that you don't have insurance. Your dependents will have to pay \$30 for normal vaccine and \$65 for high dose vaccine. Fees must be paid at Finance prior to the Clinic.
- **High Dose:** Individuals age of 65 and older are recommended to receive a high dose vaccine. You must request a high dose vaccine by registering for the 1:45 session.
- **Flexibility:** If you can't make the October 13th Clinic, you have other options. Contact HR at 314-984-6975.
