ROLLS OF BLACK TRASH BAGS AT CITY HALL

The City will not be delivering black trash bags to residents this August as in previous years. The City is discontinuing this program and will no longer be selling rolls of black trash bags at City Hall within the next year.

The Finance department will continue to sell the remaining bags we have in stock, but we expect that supply to be depleted within the next several months.

Residents can purchase similar type commercial grade 30-gallon trash bags suitable for your trash carts in bulk at local hardware stores and home improvement stores such as Home Depot, Menards, Sam's Club and Office Depot.

REMINDER: FACE MASKS ARE REQUIRED FOR ENTRY INTO ALL CITY FACILITIES INCLUDING CITY HALL, THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE TRAIN STATION, THE FARMERS MARKET AND THE AQUATIC CENTER.

- Site improvements & utilities
- New ancillary storage building
- New covered platform
- Outdoor plaza & landscaping

TOTAL ESTIMATED COST: \$3,800,000
