## II. New Business

- a. <u>Case No. 1-2021</u> Michael Clote, applicant for 513 East Jefferson Ave (R-3 Zoning District), requests variances to construct a detached garage that will not conform to both side yard setbacks, the rear yard setback, and maximum lot coverage requirements. All four variance requests were unanimously denied.
- b. <u>Case No. 2-2021</u> Derek and Keitha Troy, applicants for 406 Claybrook Lane (R-3 Zoning District), request variances to construct a screen porch addition that will not conform to the existing non-conforming rear yard setback and a deck addition that will not conform to the rear yard setback encroachment and maximum lot coverage requirement. Rear setback variance approved 4 to 1, rear encroachment variance unanimously approved, and lot coverage variance denied 1 to 4.

c. Case No. 3-2021 442 Gabriel Drive - Withdrawn.
