The need for repairs have picked up slightly with the warmer weather starting to creep up on us. We have repaired and replaced several valves and hydrants along with some water main breaks, which have popped up this past month. We also completed 10 new service taps and ran about 20 service calls, helping the residents of Kirkwood with their service line related issues. Our Manchester main relocations are still going good with us completing 3 of the 7. One more will be completed by the first week of June.

Did You Know?

Did you know that the water department has a Support Services side and a Distribution Side? Support Services takes care of all your pumps, storage tanks, towers, meter and service line issues, along with checking water quality weekly using strict guidelines to ensure the best possible water quality. Water Distribution performs and oversees the repair, maintenance and installations of all water valves, fire hydrants and the miles upon miles of water mains throughout the city.

Upcoming Projects

We are preparing for a new water main installation that will be taking place starting in June on Grand Ave. We are excited to get this project underway and hope to have it completed in about 90 days.
