The couple of hot snaps we had this past month has really kept us moving. Water Distribution has repaired 18 water main failures, repaired 1 valve, performed maintenance on 6 hydrants and completed 1 main relocation on Manchester @Bernice. Support services has performed 7 taps, 10 site inspections and has ran about 45 service calls. They also completed the quarterly state required sampling.

Upcoming Projects

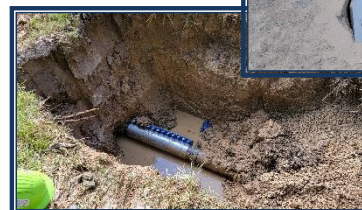
