Monthly Progress Report

I'm sure it's no surprise to hear that we have continued to be busy through the last month of summer. **Distribution** has repaired 22 water main failures, replaced 2 fire hydrants, replaced a failing section of pipe on Couch and finished our main relocations on Manchester. That is all on top of our normal day to day investigations, yard restorations, etc. **Support Services** finished out the last month of summer with 32 meter and dial replacements, performed 6 new taps, completed 6 final site inspections and ran 55 service calls.

Did You Know?

Did you know the water line that serves your home is owned by the homeowner? The city owns the meter and corporation (connection from the city main to the service line). If there is ever a leak on the service line, in certain circumstances, the repair or replacement may be covered under the county program.
